



SEPA places order for 12 loose stock dyeing machines



The Turkish company SEPA started as a cotton trader in Istanbul and in 1954 the company continued to expand. The company is still family-owned to this day and is run by the 3rd generation.

The company SEPA decided on the basis of the extremely good experience with the already 8 existing loose stock dyeing machines for the purchase of 12 further loose stock dyeing machines from KTM-KRANTZ. The machines with a capacity of 1,000kg and 1,500kg are used for bleaching cotton. One loose stock dyeing machine can bleach up to 6 batches a day.

The machine meets all standards regarding occupational safety & environmental regulations and is prepared and equipped for industry 4.0.
